

TeX Live 2013 released

TeX Live 2013 has been released. TeX Live is a comprehensive TeX and LaTeX system running on Windows, Mac OS X, Linux and other Unix operating systems. For Mac OS X, a special version MacTeX 2013 is available.

Some of the changes to TeX Live 2012:

- The top-level texmf/ directory has been merged into texmf-dist/.
- MetaPost provides native support for PNG output and IEEE double floating-point support has been added.
- XeTeX has been significantly updated with Graphite2, HarfBuzz and Core Text on the Mac.
- LuaTeX now bases on Lua 5.2 and contains a new library pdfscanner for processing external PDF pages.
- xdvipdfmx now renders with FreeType instead of t1lib.
- microtype supports protrusion with XeTeX and LuaTeX and font expansion plus tracking for the latter.
- tlmgr works better with with multiple repositories.
